

Current Balance: \$12,368.76

Tournament of Love and Beauty had a profit of \$643. Lunch profit was \$223. Don't know if anything specific was discussed for lunch profit. Since no one remembered it went to general funds.

St. Paddy's Day Bloodbath had a profit of \$322. It was discussed whether paying the park was double dipping. Sir Thomas explained that the park gets \$50 up front and a percentage of what we and merchants make in order to get a license. Sir Thomas will check to see if we owe the park anything.

Sunday Social Fund: \$267.60

The site is paid through the spring. This does not include funds from the last few weeks.

Coranet Fund: \$920

A vote was taken to see if we continue the fund as the year time for the fund is up. It was voted not to transfer the money into the general money but to continue the fund.
