News & Announcements (continued)

The Barony of Ponte Alto will host Chalice of the Sun God on Saturday, October 19, 2013 at Loudoun County Fairgrounds in Leesburg, Virginia.

This year is our 10th Chalice. In the previous nine events, we have honored the gods and goddesses of classical mythology. This year, we shine our attention upon the Sun God himself, Apollo, son of Leto and Zeus and twin of Artemis. Apollo was tasked with driving his chariot across the sky, bringing light to the world. Therefore, our theme for this anniversary year is "Chariot of Apollo".

We honor the Sun God with competitions in armored, rapier, archery, youth combat, A&S, and Bardic/Performance. The winner of each competition will challenge the 2012 Chalice Champion in that discipline. The winners receive bragging rights, the duty to challenge next year's winners, and of course, CHOCOLATE!

The Barony's MoAS, Lady Beibhinn Mhodartha (Kristin Moran) announces that the A&S competitions will be Bardic and Artifact A&S. The theme for both is anything that relates to Apollo. This includes his chariot, the sun, and horses, as well as his other symbols including the laurel tree, bow and arrow, tripod, lyre (stringed instrument), and dolphin. For Bardic, bards and other performers shall compete in a Challenger's Competition for the right to face the Chalice Bard. Each bard or performer should have 2 pieces prepared, one of which shall be in period-style and documented. For the Artifact Chalice Competition, artisans shall compete in a Challenger's Competition for the right to face the Chalice Artisan.

All can compete in individual disciplines and as part of a team. Teams must field a single participant in 4 of the 5 Chalice disciplines. A team may include up to 3 Youth participants. Each participant shall receive points for participation and performance (extra points are awarded for youth participation!). The team with the highest score will be declared the winner of the Chalice of the Sun God.

For the past three years, our neighboring Barony of Stierbach has won the team competition. Will they retain the honor or be unseated by another contender? So start on your A&S projects, your bardic performances; begin to prepare your equipment and assemble your team! The event is only 2 ½ months away!



Mom, Dad... AGAIN this weekend?

Most children go to SCA events because their parents do. It's fun to dress in garb and be outside the house on a Saturday and/or Sunday. Weekend or week-long wars are great—kids get to camp AND be outside playing. But playing and running around can get boring, especially as youth grow. After a while, they'd probably like to learn why their parents spend their time in the SCA and what makes the Society so special.

The Atlantian Pages Academy offers youth of the Kingdom a chance to learn about the Society and the Middle Ages. Anyone who is between the ages of 5 and 17 years old can be a Page. This is a wonderful program that offers youth the chance to gain skills and knowledge, and give them the opportunity to be involved in a productive way in Atlantia. It helps make events fun for curious kids.

How does it work? Teachers and Mentors teach chivalry, honor, responsibility, courtesy, leadership and history. This can be done through Page Academy classes that are held during events or at a local fighter practice or A&S night where, for example, youth might sit with someone and learn about embroider for an hour. A Mentor is not required to get started in the Academy, but having one is encouraged—they can help guide a child's progress as a Page and connect them with other adults who can teach them skills. A Mentor is someone the parent(s) find; this person will "foster personal growth, as well as help you develop courtly skills and an understanding of service, courtesy, and fealty. The relationship should mirror that of Peers and their Squires, Apprentices, or Protégés.

To get started, you have to fill out an enrollment form and submit it to the Kingdom Chancellor of Family and Youth Programs. Then, arrangements will be made for an induction ceremony with the Queen present. An induction ceremony is not required, but it's really neat to do! Once you're inducted into the Pages Academy, you'll wear a blue baldric adorned with a simple white chalice. Pages begin as Novices, and progress to Cupbearers and then onto Senior Pages. The Vice Chancellor of the Pages Academy tracks the progress of Pages; kids and parent(s) are encouraged to keep a record, too. Be sure to write down any activities and the hour(s) spent on them; any and all experience in the SCA can be counted towards credits.

Anyone can attend a Pages Academy class when they are offered at events, provided the youth are between the ages of 5 and 17 years old. You can try it out before making a commitment to become a Page.

The website is also where kids, parents, and a potential Mentor can get all the information they need—just click on "For Pages", "For Parents", or "For Mentors". To download files with the enrollment form, click on "Forms".

So instead of kids dreading an event and asking "why do I have to go?", this is a great opportunity for them to learn what the Society is about and "grow" the future populace of the SCA.

The Order of the Alcyon honors and recognizes those young people (up to and including the age of 17), who have distinguished themselves by their labors and achievements in the arts and sciences.

The Award of Arielle honors and recognizes those young people (up to and including the age of 17), who have distinguished themselves by their acts of courtesy.


