News & Announcements *(Continued)*

The Barony of Ponte Alto will host Chalice of the Sun God on Saturday, October 19, 2013 at Loudoun County Fairgrounds in Leesburg, Virginia. The event was originally 'spiked' for September 27-29, but a glitch with the site forced me to change the date and location. I apologize for any confusion.

This year is our 10th Chalice. In the previous nine events, we have honored the gods and goddesses of classical mythology. This year, we shine our attention upon the Sun God himself, Apollo, son of Leto and Zeus and twin of Artemis. Apollo was tasked with driving his chariot across the sky, bringing light to the world. Therefore, our theme for this anniversary year is "Chariot of Apollo".

We honor the Sun God with competitions in armored, rapier, archery, youth combat, A&S, and Bardic/Performance. The winner of each competition will challenge the 2012 Chalice Champion in that discipline. The winners receive bragging rights, the duty to challenge next year's winners, and of course, CHOCOLATE!

The Barony's MoAS, Lady Beibhinn Mhodartha (Kristen Moran) announces that the A&S competitions will be Bardic and Artifact A&S. The theme for both is anything that relates to Apollo. This includes his chariot, the sun, and horses, as well as his other symbols including the laurel tree, tripod, lyre (stringed instrument), and dolphin. For Bardic, bards and other performers shall compete in a Challenger's Competition for the right to face the Chalice Bard. Each bard or performer should have 2 pieces prepared, one of which shall be in period-style and documented. For the Artifact Chalice Competition, artisans shall compete in a Challenger's Competition for the right to face the Chalice Artisan.

All can compete in individual disciplines and as part of a team. Teams must field a single participant in 4 of the 5 Chalice disciplines. A team may include up to 3 Youth participants. Each participant shall receive points for participation and performance (extra points are awarded for youth participation!). The team with the highest score will be declared the winner of the Chalice of the Sun God.

For the past three years, our neighboring Barony of Stierbach has won the team competition. Will they retain the honor or be unseated by another contender? So start on your A&S projects, your bardic performances; begin to prepare your equipment and assemble your team! The event is only 4 months away!

Archery Competition at Chalice

OYEZ OYEZ OYEZ

For this year's Archery Competition at Chalice, there will be prizes for the top three (3) overall scores by archers using a Period Hand-Bow. Period style recurves and longbows of any material are allowed. Modern style recurves or longbows with full or partial center cut risers are not allowed. There is no weight limit, maximum or minimum. Period style bows are defined as: Any style of bow that can be documented as used in pre-1600 archery, from Stone age bows to English longbows. Construction materials should be mainly those that were used in period for the making of that style of bow. Modern materials such as synthetic glues, finishes, fibers (strings) or artificial sinew are allowed as long as their use does not give an unfair advantage in performance over period materials. Fiberglass may be used as a substitute for horn and or sinew in the construction of period style recurve bows such as Arab, Turkish, Mongol, etc., but no modern features such as full or partial center cut handles are allowed. This last is important. Many modern longbows have some center-cut on their handle part (riser in a recurve). If that is the case, the bow is not allowed in the Period division. A protruding shelf resulting from layers of leather on the handle is allowed, however. The bow must have the appearance of a period laminate bow. Composite longbows (of different woods or backed with sinew or rawhide, etc.) are allowed. Bows do not have to conform to the persona of the archer.

ARROWS: Wood shafts of any wood, cane or bamboo are allowed. Fletching must be of feathers.

RELEASE AIDS: Archers may use any period style release appropriate for their bow, but are not required to do so. For example, an archer may use a glove or tab instead of a thumb ring while shooting an Eastern style bow.

STRINGS: Modern string materials are allowed, as well as period materials. Please exercise caution for a period material string.

ARROW RESTS: Non period arrow rests are not allowed. Built in full or partial windows are not allowed. See fuller description above.
