A Challenge from our Baronessa

Greetings Ponte Alto!

I have challenges for all those who may be THINKING about fighting in Fall 2014, Spring 2015 or Fall 2015 Atlantia Crown Tournaments:

1. If you will fight for either the Baroness OR the Baron of Ponte Alto, I will make a matching set of garb for Tourney Day. Should you win, I will make, at least, two more sets of garb for your Reign.

With this challenge to you, there are some responsibilities to the seamstress:

- a. I must know at least two months from the date the letters are due to the Crown that you intend to enter Crown Tourney (so sizes, patterns, etc. may be obtained). Generally this is 2 weeks from Crown Tourney - however, the more notice, the better.
- b. You must be accepted to participate in Crown Tourney.
- c. You must notify the seamstress IMMEDIATELY that you have been accepted to participate in Crown Tourney (so the mad garb making may commence!).

A second Challenge:-)

- 2. To anyone else who may be THINKING about fighting in Fall 2014, Spring 2015 or Fall 2015 Atlantian Crown Tournaments: I will make heraldic banners for you to carry in the precession. Same responsibilities apply:
 - a. I must know at least two months from the date the letters are due to the Crown that you intend to enter Crown Tourney (so correct depictions of your and your consort's arms may be obtained). Generally this is 2 weeks from Crown Tourney however, the more notice, the better.
 - b. You must be accepted to participate in Crown Tourney.
 - c. You must notify me IMMEDIATELY that you have been accepted to participate in Crown Tourney (so the mad banner making may commence!).

Ponte Alto, I know you are up to this challenge. Fall 2014 is the first Crown Tournament this challenge applies to, and October 1st is the deadline for when I need to know if you are accepting my challenge!

Chalice of the Sun God XI Golden Age of the Titans Saturday, October 25, 2014

This year, we honor the Titans, the predecessors/parents to the Greek Gods. We will have competitions in armored, rapier, archery, A&S, and Bardic/Performance. We have chosen one Titan to inspire competitors in each discipline. A&S and Bardic/Performance can look to any of these Titans for inspiration for their entries. (Please note that you're A&S entries are not required to use these inspirations.)

A&S Astraeus, the Titan god of stars and planets, and the art of astrology.

Bardic/Performance Mnemosyne, the personification of memory or remembrance. She rep-

resented the rote memorization required, before the introduction of writing, to preserve the stories of history and sagas of myth. It is said that Kings and Poets receive their powers of authoritative speech from her.

Lelantos, the younger Titan god of air and the hunter's skill of stalking Archery

> prey. His name was derived from the Greek words lêthô, lanthanô, and lelathon, meaning "to escape notice," "move unseen" or "go unob-

served."

Heavy Fighting Perses, the Titan god of destruction. Enough said!

Rapier Pallas, the Titan god of warcraft. He was the father of Victory, Rivalry,

Strength and Power by Styx (Hate), children who turned to the side of Zeus during the Titan-War. Pallas' name was derived from the Greek

word pallô meaning "to brandish (a spear)."

We hope to have Youth Combat if Marshals are available.

The winner of each competition will challenge the 2013 Chalice Champion in that discipline. The winners receive bragging rights, the duty to challenge next year's winners, and of course, CHOCO-LATE!

All can compete in individual disciplines and as part of a team. Teams must field a single participant in 4 of the 5 Chalice disciplines. A team may include up to 3 Youth participants. Each participant shall receive points for participation and performance (extra points are awarded for youth participation!). The team with the highest score will be declared the winner of the Chalice of the Sun God. For the past four years, our neighboring Barony of Stierbach has won the team competition. Will they retain the honor or be unseated by another contender?

This year will also see the return of the Children's Marshmallow Battle, sponsored by Lady Theresa O Cahir, the Event Steward.


