Ponte Alto Baronial Investiture February 20, 2016

Come help us reminisce about the 5-year reign and many good deeds of Baron Drogo and Baroness Adina, and watch Their Royal Majesties invest Lord Alric the Mad and Lady Cellach Mór as the new Baron and Baroness of Ponte Alto. Even though Fat Tuesday will have been 11 days prior, we'll celebrate our Italian heritage with the theme "Carnevale in an Italian Town Square". Italian garb is not required; Vikings, Celts, Mongols, Germans, etc. are welcome!

In addition to the Investiture, there will also be many opportunities for performances of song, poetry, storytelling, dance, and all of the Bardic arts. Any works can be performed, it does not have to be an original composition.

The new Baron and Baroness will be selecting their Baronial A&S Champion and Baronial Bardic Champion. Details for the competitions will be forthcoming.

The Poeta Atlantiae, Katarzyna Witkowska, is sponsoring a medieval poetry competition. The theme is to write a poem honoring your barony, or its people, or your present or past baronage. If you are not from Ponte Alto, write about your own barony. There will be a youth and an adult competition. Documentation is encouraged and earns extra points but is not required.

In keeping with the theme, attendees will have a chance to make a mask to wear at their pleasure. Children will be included in the day's festivities, and if the weather is mild we can have paleo races outside. In lieu of martial activities, there will be a Marshmallow Battle (a.k.a. a game of "Pelt the Autocrat"). Materials to make handheld catapults and marshmallows will be provided.



Coronet

A coronet is a small crown consisting of ornaments fixed on a metal ring. By one definition, a coronet differs from a crown in that a coronet never has arches, and from a tiara in that a coronet completely encircles the head, while a tiara does not. By a slightly different definition, a crown is worn by an emperor, empress, king or queen; a coronet by a nobleman or lady. ...

The word stems from the Old French coronete, a diminutive of co(u)ronne ("crown"), itself from the Latin corona (also "wreath"), from the Ancient Greek κορώνη (korōnē, "garland, wreath").

Traditionally, such headgear is – as indicated by the German equivalent Adelskrone (literally "crown of nobility") – used by nobles and by princes and princesses in their coats of arms, rather than by monarchs, for whom the word crown is customarily reserved in formal English, while many languages have no such terminological distinction. Other than a crown, a coronet shows the rank of the respective noble. Hence, in German and Scandinavian languages there is also the term Rangkrone.
