*This month we begin a new series, **Ponte Alto Profiles**, where we hope to put a spotlight on some of the people that make up the grand Barony of Ponte Alto. It seems only appropriate to start off our first profile on the Baron himself, Alric the Mad! We hope you enjoy reading!*

Profile: Alric the Mad

Who are you?

Alric The Mad, current Baron of Ponte Alto, Atlantia. Member, Order of the White Scarf, Order of the Golden Dolphin, Order of St Aidan.

How did you find the SCA?

It's complicated. I first met some folks from the Central NY group (Coppertree) at a restaurant. Later I ran into more at the NY Ren Faire. They told me they were going to something called 'Pennsic' after the faire closed. Someone a few years previous I played D&D with had mentioned this thing call 'Pennsic' and I asked questions. I re-connected with those

folks from the local group and that was my first event. Pennsic 23.

What hooked you?

The people I met and all the options. These folks were doing all kinds of crazy things like hitting each other with sticks and stabbing each other with rapiers. Doing first aid stuff, cooking, drinking home made adult beverages. It was amazing.

Current/Next project:

We are working on beautifying our household encampment at large events like Gulf Wars. To that end we are making some big silk banners and they will need a way to fly them. I'm going to be making some tall flag poles we can pack up fairly small and quickly set up.

Favorite SCA Event:

Pennsic was my first favorite and now runs a close second to Gulf Wars. For both, it is an opportunity to test myself physically, as I fight in as many melee scenarios as I can fit in, and I get to see friends that I can only see at those events.

How do you stay busy at events?

See above. In general, I can be found fighting on the rapier or armored field/lists most days. I do try and get to the A&S displays, especially if residents of Ponte Alto have submitted their works. I'm also trying to get to the archery range more often. At Pennsic, you will also find me at the Children's Fete running the Palio races.

What Activity do you *not* do that you would like to try:

I've done a little of almost everything. The newest is Equestrian. I'd love to be able to make more time for that.

What advice would you offer someone just getting started?

Try everything! Ask questions! *Everyone* in the SCA tries to be helpful in their own way. The first person you ask may not be the right person for you, but there is always someone who can be helpful in a way that works for you.

What is the SCA to you?

Mostly, family of choice. I have made so many amazing friends (and some of those have passed on) and make more at every event I go to. Most of these people are a special part of my life and I'll choose going to events over many other entertainment options so I can spend time with them.

- ◆ More promotion/advertising of the event!
- ◆ Need volunteers for troll, etc. Adina volunteered for Hall Steward.
- ◆ Discussion of foodstuffs.

- ◆ Note: there is heat in the hall, but not in the barn.

- ◆ Discussion of leather coronets. Already have 3 (in 3 sizes) for regular use. Discussion of adjustable coronets with replaceable plate, like Lochmere.
- ◆ (Kel) Coronation is coming up. There are cabins available. Option for a Baronial cabin? Discussion about decorating the space? Ottoman style.
- ◆ (Vadoma) Spring Crown bid rejected. Fall Crown deadline has already passed, but still needs bids.
 - ◆ Penciled in the Loudon Co. Fairgrounds if we want to make a bid.
 - ◆ A budget was drafted up (will need some adjustments).
 - ◆ Adina volunteered to autocrat with Vadoma as assistant.
 - ◆ Geoffrey inserted as MiC (as placeholder for bid).
 - ◆ Discussion of fees for attendees. \$15 at door. \$13 pre-reg. \$12 feast (reduced to \$10).
 - ◆ Adjust budget from \$800 to \$600, and 60 to 50 people.
 - ◆ Add an additional portajohn (1 to be accessible).
 - ◆ Balances out to roughly the same budget.
 - ◆ Need to add PayPal fees to budget.
 - ◆ \$200 troll advance. 260 break even.
 - ◆ Budget passed. Adjustments by Emergency Committee. Pkg to be submitted this week.
- ◆ (Aine & Kel) Possible joint Stierbach and Ponte Alto event?
- ◆ (Alric) Baron of Storvik has spiked a Spring Faire event. Possible event with responsibilities shared among several baronies. Each barony might pick/cover one activity. Same weekend as Queen's Rapier, and only 2 months to plan, so the event is only tentative. Suggestion that we host the archery activity?
- ◆ (Seamus) Discussion about the meeting place for the Populace Gathering.
 - ◆ Tysons-Pimmitt Library reserved potentially for next month (Mary to check). Have to do walk-thru. Have to book from 4:30 as that's the last reservation time. May conflict with another event at that location. Mary to discuss with Adina.
 - ◆ (Seamus) Dogfish Head at Seven Corners a possibility. Have a

party room. Able to book months in advance.

- ◆ Discussion of concerns about hosting at restaurants where people may feel obligated to order food. People certainly welcome to attend, and then stick around for dinner/socializing, but no one should feel obligated to spend money to attend the meeting.
- ◆ The old place is still available. Point person still needs to be a church attendee.
- ◆ (Adina) Anita's (New Mexican cuisine) as a possible location. Near the old church site. Near 50.
- ◆ (Mary) The Nutley St. Safeway has a meeting room that could be used.
- ◆ (Mary) County District Center as a possible venue as well. Fairfax center is free. Arlington has a \$30 fee.
- ◆ (Alric) We need to be able to book locations at least 2 months ahead (and preferably 4 months ahead).

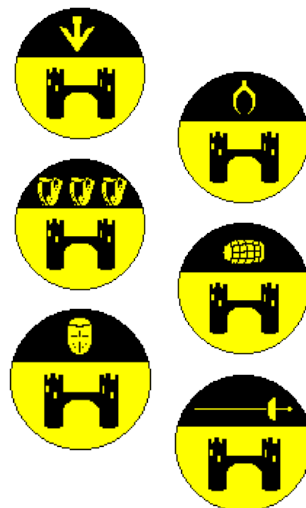

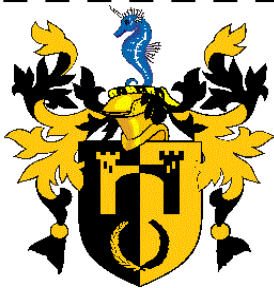
