Revenge of the Stitch

The Tudors Season Five, Episode One: Revenge of the Stitch, in which Jonathan Rhys Meyers takes yet another hiatus from the show and is replaced by Baron Alric the Mad during a 24-hour sewing bonanza.

Every year in Fair Lady Atlantia there is an event — nay, a crucible — held to test the speed and skill of the great garb-makers of this Kingdom. This event, called Revenge of the Stitch and hosted by the Shire of Spiaggia Levantina, pits teams of six against one another to see who can craft the most beautiful and most accurate creation — from the skin out — in just 24 hours. Teams are judged by six categories: historical accuracy & documentation, construction: fabric, trim, & accessories, construction: sewing, construction: level of intricacy, ensemble, and hand-sewing. This year our Barony of Ponte Alto fielded a team of six, plus one model, in order to compete in this extraordinary challenge, registered under the name Resting Stitch Face — yes, we are hilarious. Team members consisted of Mistress Drea de Pellegryn (mka Drea Leed), Lady Amie Sparrow (mka Amiee Kratts), Lord Stephan Grimm (mka Scott Webb), Lady Margaret Lad (mka Megan Ladd), Vadoma (mka Marlene Martineau), and Lady Leonor Cuerva de Segovia y Avila (mka Jessica Girven). The model for the team was His Excellency, Baron Alric the Mad.

Planning for the team began in November 2017. We were ambitious from the start — drawing inspiration from the 1536 portrait of King Henry VIII by the German artist, Hans Holbein the Younger.

Revenge of the Stitch (cont.)

Because of the complexity and level of intricacy involved in this particular ensemble, the team used its strengths in project planning and management in order to streamline the organization and creation process. Following the event, Mistress Drea ran the final numbers:

- 6 crazy people
- 10 pre-event meetings
- 6 yards of hand-couched embroidery
- 150+ hours of prep and research
- 52 yards of fabric
- 108 fabric pattern pieces
- 74 post-it notes
- 60 hand-cast and hand-decorated jewels
- 52 hand-stitched puffs
- 24 hours of constant sewing with 4 hours (on average) of sleep, to produce:
- 1 Fantabulous Ensemble with 2 minutes to spare!



