Rosemary & Sea Salt Roasted Pecans

Rosemary & Sea Salt Roasted Pecans

6 tbsp butter

1 tbsp rosemary

1 tbsp sea salt

1/2 tsp cayenne pepper

4 cups shelled and halved pecans

Preheat oven to 325 degrees. Melt the butter in a large saucepan. Remove from the heat and add seasonings. Add pecans. Toss well. Place in one layer in a shallow baking dish or baking sheet on



parchment paper. Roast for 10-15 minutes, stirring occasionally. Remove and allow to dry for ~24 hours.


