

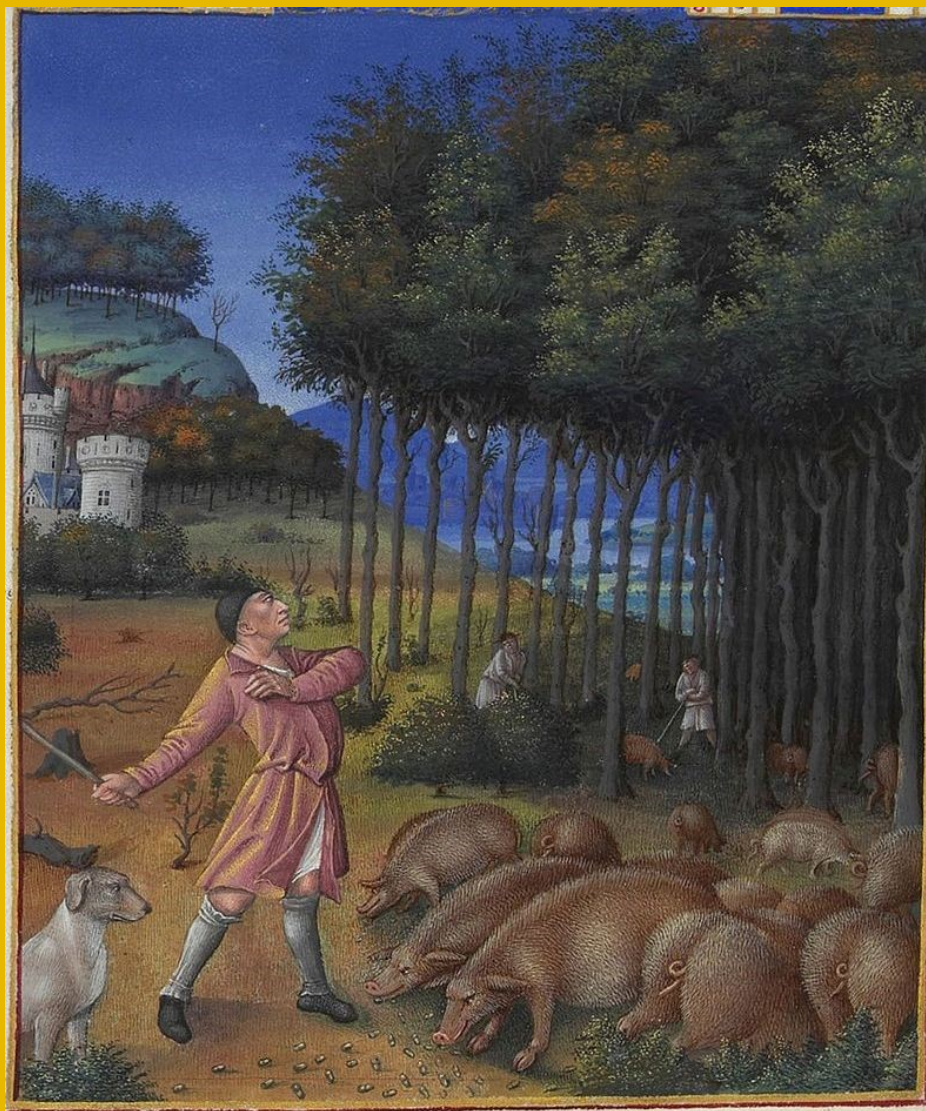

- ◆ *From Naran:*
- ◆ Posted on PA FB site. New banners!
- ◆ Working on awards for Yule

- ◆ Working on stuff for Yule court.
- ◆ *From MT:*
- ◆ Discussed with Naran the extended pandemic reign. Would like to get a variance for their "reign of terror" before the polling.
- ◆ Question to Seamus, who initiates the Variance request? Seneschal? Or the B&B? Who submits? Answer: B&B should apply to K&Q for the variance (e.g. for the duration of COVID).

- ◆ Discussion about recording and publishing of the event. (Marion) Will use local Zoom, and then publish to Kingdom Youtube. Will be reaching out to Kingdom Webminister, Melchior, ahead of time.
- ◆ Marion might be able to get a camera. She will look into it. So Marion will also be present. Hakon can also check his Rebel. Older, but might work.
- ◆ Sof'ia need backdrop(s) from storage. Plus the clamshells. The frame thing. Holiday background. Banner holders.
- ◆ Sof'ia donated a backdrop. Should be in storage. Adina will check.
- ◆ (Adina) Chairs? (MT) will use their X chairs with a small table between.
- ◆ (MT) We do need at least 1 banner with our heraldry. (Adina) Use the pennant. It's smaller.
- ◆ (Adina) has face shields
- ◆ Still don't know what the weather will be like. For inside vs. outside.
- ◆ (Adina) Cookies. Have people take (and submit) pictures. Send to A&S? Send to B&B?
- ◆ Use a Google form. Then we can set up a gallery page so everyone can see them. With the recipes?
- ◆ Will be judged by B&B
- ◆ Marion will add to her write-up for it on Monday.
- ◆ (Adina) What champions to be selected? Heavy, Fencing, Archery, A&S, Bardic. Not Brewing? Push Brewing to Pennsic (but see if anyone submits).
- ◆ (Drogo) Wait for Bloodbath for Heavy & Fencing?
- ◆ (MT) Wearing the colors at Events. Not much else asked of them. Would like to see participation and teaching. Followed by some discussion about the duties of the champions. (Adina) Say "charged with doing this."
- ◆ What time to do court? 2PM?
- ◆ (Adina) Need to do a court report ahead of time! So they can work on the timing. Need SCA name and modern.
- ◆ 19th meet around noon.

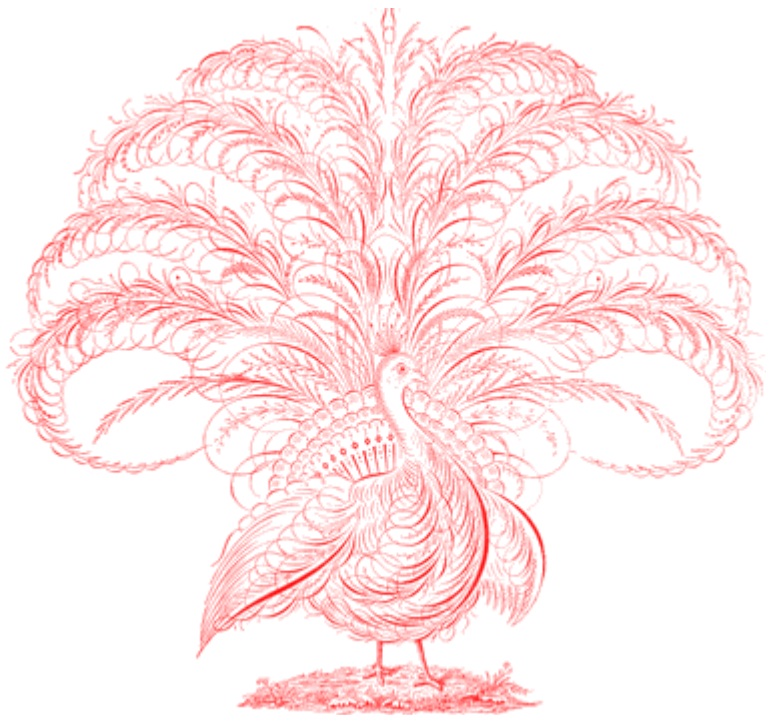

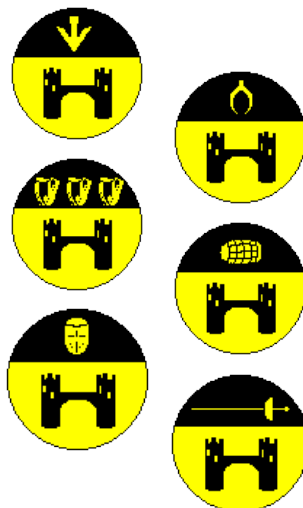

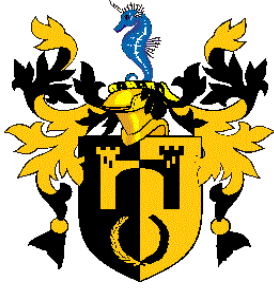
Who can retain?
