



Feature Article

Blind Dice (break the bank or house profits?) Article by Lisbet of Spinning Winds

This webpage came up in a search for pre-17th century games https://fleurtyherald.wordpress.com/2014/09/19/gaming-on-the-italian-peninsula/. The game uses six dice cubes, each having a number from one to six on one side with the other five sides blank. The total of all six dice is twenty-one. The game is played by one player at a time taking on the house. The player puts up a stake, then rolls the dice, and the payoffs are as follows:

It would be easy to use what we know about typical six-sided dice probabilities and say there are 64 distinguishable die rolls and assume this payoff table would quickly bankrupt the house. There is only one possible roll (blank, blank, blank, blank, blank, blank, blank, blank, and 42 of 64 possible out-

Number Rolled	Payoff
0	Player loses stake to the house
1-8	Player keeps the stake
9 – 10	House pays an amount equal to the stake
11 – 12	Pays twice the stake
13	Pays three times the stake
14	Pays four times the stake
15	Pays five times the stake
16	Pays ten times the stake
17	Pays fifteen times the stake
18	Pays twenty times the stake
19	Pays twenty-five times the stake
20	Pays fifty times the stake
21	Pays ninety times the stake

comes where the house pays out. However, these are NOT typical dice.

If these were fair coins numbered on one side and blank on the other, the house would go bankrupt. For a stake of 3, the player outcomes range from -3 to gain 270 and the house's expected outcome is losing 16. Tossing fair two-sided coins, the 90X payout for 21 would be unsustainable; even setting rolls 0 through 20 to "player loses the stake" gives an outcome biased against the house (expect to pay out 42% of the stake). Changing that to 63X for a coin toss of 21 gives an expected outcome for both house and player of 0.

Instead, we have *special* dice.

Feature Article

On each die, the probability of rolling a number is 1/6 and the probability of rolling a blank is 5/6 which give us this table of probabilities for the 64 outcomes. Each roll, there is about a 1 in 3 chance that the payer will lose the stake; the likelihood that neither side profits is 56%; and there is only a 0.002% chance of a 90X payout. Over repeated plays, the house

should expect a profit of 11.6% of the stakes.
