





Come, share with us adventures in the great Barony of Ponte Alto, in the grand Kingdom of Atlantia, in this - the current Middle Ages!


News & Announcements

Seneschal – Lord Hákon brimill (David Hultman)


- 2-week period of flux. All in person events are shut down, and all events are virtual







A&S Activities

A&S Update from Lady Mariana Ruiz de Medina

Happy February Ponte Alto!

We have begun our Savory Food block this month. Our first class covered a variety of resources for food related A&S including some great websites as well as the Wayback Machine, to help make use of possibly archived SCA related materials. I can't wait to see what everyone has done for those projects at the end of the month. As a reminder, for each person who sends me pictures or a write up of their project once the block is complete, I will have a token for you. Our recipes of the week have been going well too.

The first week, we discussed how translations can affect recipes drastically. MedievalCookery.com is one of my go-to resources for recipes from all over the world, both translations and redactions. This week's recipe of the week is from Germany (thinking ahead to our next block) and [*Ein Buch von guter speise*](#). This recipe, called King's Chicken (number 28), is a spiced and roasted chicken dish featuring some classic spices found in our period: anise, ginger, and saffron. What makes this recipe fun is that different translations give you very different results! One translation by [Melitta Anderson](#) has the dish almost [casserole or pie like](#), with a ground chicken filling. Another translation (linked above in the book title) does not include this grinding, but instead has larger pieces of chicken that are then roasted with the eggs and herbs.

The next week, we took a look at how ingredients we may be familiar with in mundane life can be interpreted differently in medieval cooking. This week's recipe of the week comes from another favorite SCA food resource and features a tie into our favorite saint of the day. The first thing to note is that it's not actually a savory recipe but could very easily belong at home in a cheese course or other savory remove. One of Saint Valentine's patronages is beekeepers, and so choosing a honey recipe felt fitting for the day. This recipe highlights one of my favorite things about medieval cooking, which is the challenge to change our perspectives as modern eaters. Mundanely, ginger, cinnamon, and honey feature often prominently in sweeter applications, but their uses are varied, and they are delicious in savory applications too. In this recipe in particular, the black pepper brings out the smokier, more savory notes of the other two spices very pleasantly! Try this recipe with a soft ripened goat cheese and it'll really shine. [Find the recipe here](#).






We really could use your help!






Who can retain?
