Garb Attempts: Norse Jewelry

When I was making my first SCA garb ever for the 2021 St. Paddy's Day Blood Bath, I had need of the turtle broaches and string of beads. Since this was part of my first ever attempt at garb, and I already knew this wouldn't be my permanent persona, I did what anyone would do: I went to Joann's and ordered off Amazon.

At Joann's I bought some clay beads with patterns, some abalone shell beads, and some colorful dyed-stone beads to make this. I also got this pendant which I am well aware is not historically accurate. But it's pretty, and I'm fairly certain this passes the 10 ft rule, so I'm good. The broaches I purchased off of Amazon, and again, since this isn't my persona and they pass the 10 ft rule, we're golden.







The jewelry is two strings, because I'm extra, and the beads are strung on copper wire rather than any sort of thread. I'm clumsy, and often careless and forgetful, so making sure this was sturdy was important. That, and I tried making it out of thread and I didn't like how it hung. Stringing the beads on wire make the whole thing sturdier.

When I made this piece, I made the wire for the two strands connected. It's one piece. The idea is that as I was attaching the straps of the apron dress to the body, I would slip the copper loops of the bead string through the pins. I don't know how accurate or not that was, but it worked and stayed in place the entire day. I did not lose either the beads or broaches.

I think it turned out rather well! And no matter the height of the straps-to-body placement of the turtle broaches, the necklace hangs well. So, success! If I were to do this again, I would look for more period-accurate beads and pendants.



Art Spotlight: Textile Fragment

circa mid-16th century



From the Met's website:

Woven silk was an integral part of the Ottoman economy and an important trade item that yielded substantial revenue to the Ottoman treasury. It was also a sign of accumulated individual wealth and ranked alongside precious gems and metals as an indication of affluence. The choice of colors in this fragment is restricted to a blue ground with the pattern picked out in white, salmon pink, gold, and silver. The bold and forceful design of palmettes is softened by the graceful overlapping stem systems in the interstices. The palmettes, which form the heart of the ogival framework, are composed of three medallions: the innermost has a spiky outline with a tulip tree placed on a dotted ground, the middle one has a serrated edge anchoring an acanthus-type leaf facing the center, and the largest is decorated with palmette trees and a scalloped edge made of leaves.
