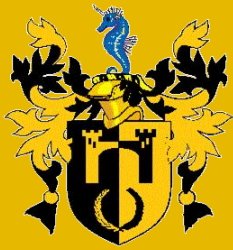

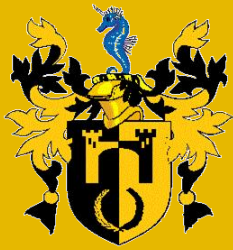

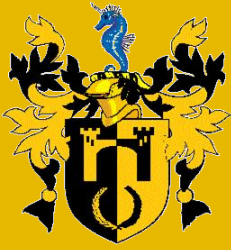

Knight Marshal - Lord Hákon brimill on behalf of Lord Jacques Gonse

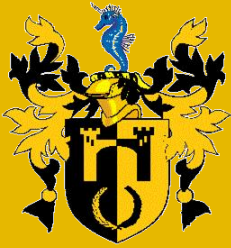
- Continues to heal and recover.

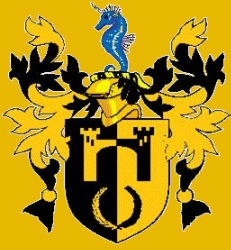
- At current Ponte Alto does not have any events on the Schedule

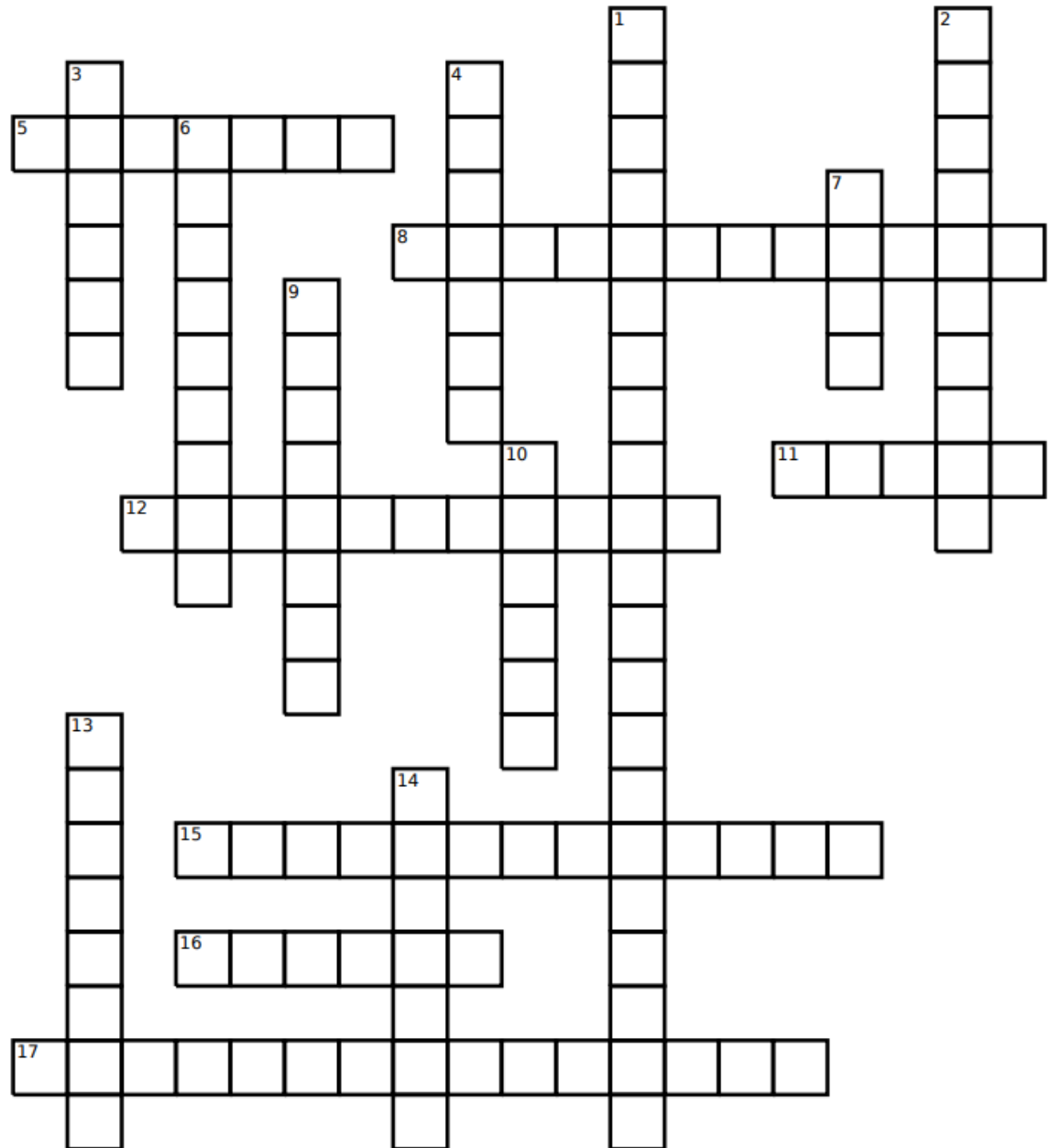

Many Games, One Board Part 2

The game Alquerque as described in the famous 13th century Book of Games by Alfonso X is between two evenly matched sides. From the same source, twelve hunters try to surround the aggressive hare before it removes them in Catch the Hare. Tigers and twenty goats roam the board in two Asian games (Bagh Chal and Bagh Guti). In North and Central America, Picaria (a three-in-a row game) and El Coyote (a coyote versus twelve chicken or sheep) use similar boards missing a few lines.

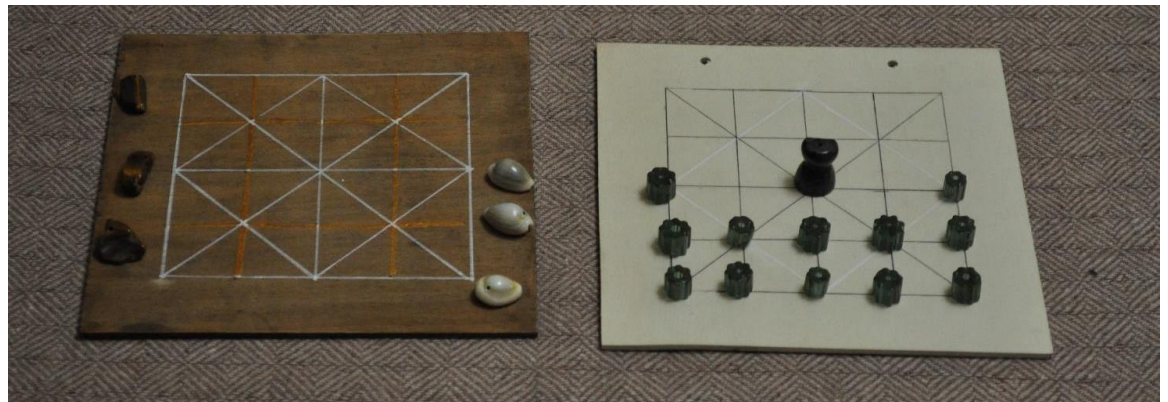
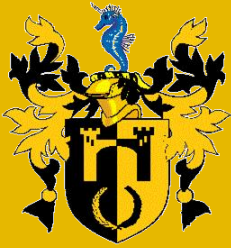


Figure 2. Picaria and El Coyote Game Boards. Photo by author.

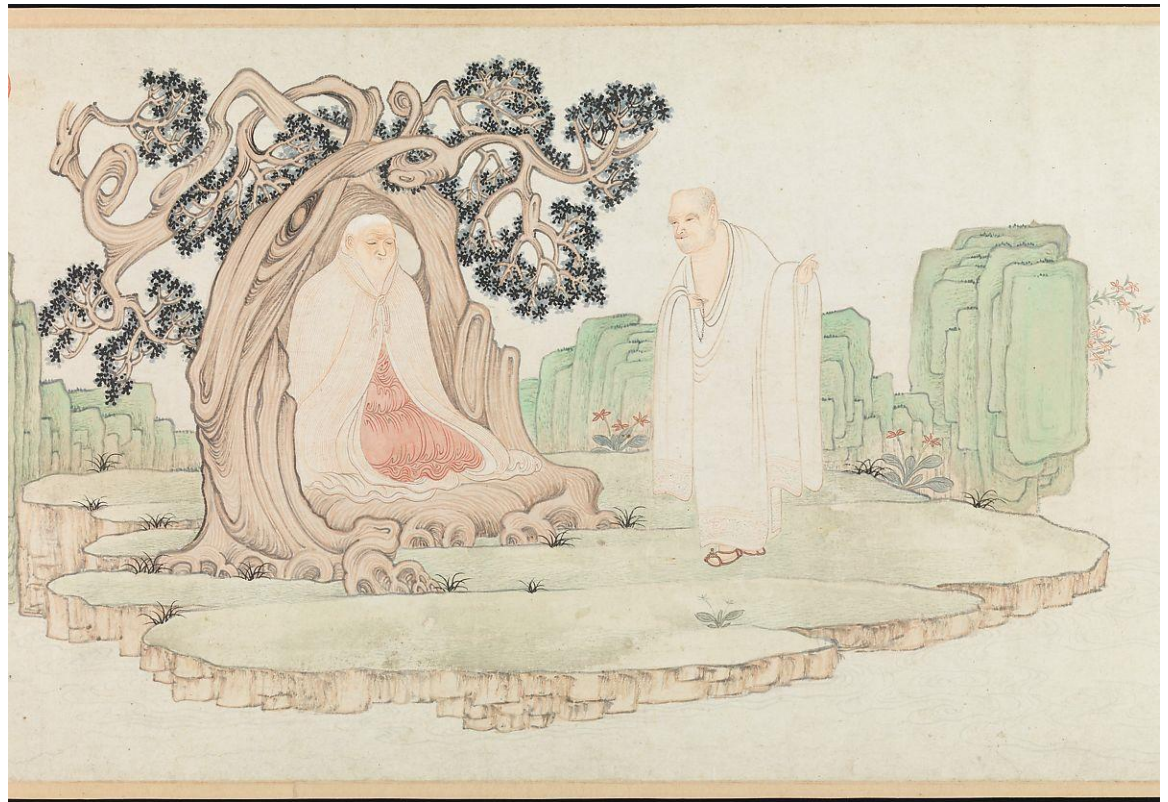
With deputies, the workload can be shared, allowing more work to be accomplished with less time and stress for any one individual.

Art Spotlight: The Sixteen Luohans

Wu Bin, Chinese, circa 1591



From the Met's website:

In the Chinese popular imagination, mendicant monks, conjurers, and mysterious hermits were often thought to be disguised “living luohans,” or Buddhist holy men capable of producing miracles. When government corruption and ineptitude imperiled social order, as it did in late Ming times, such superstitious messianic beliefs became more widespread. Here, in one of his earliest extant works, Wu Bin embraced an archaic figure style and followed the tradition of depicting luohans as fantastic eccentrics whose grotesque features belie their inner spiritual nature. Wu’s humorous painting may have had a serious message: holiness can be concealed within an outwardly incongruous form.
