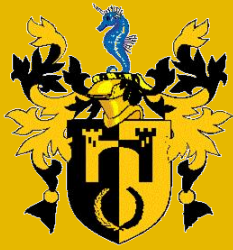

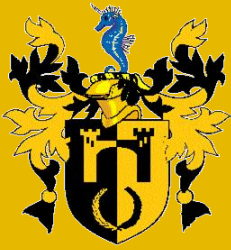

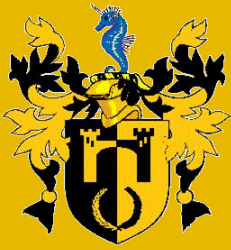

Seneschal – Lord Hákon brimill (David Hultman)

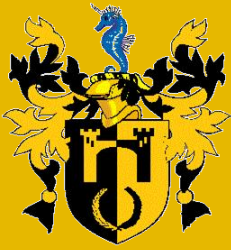
- No COVID policies update

- \$10,323.70

- Adina – have you paid yourself for the storage shed?

Herald – Lady Johanna le Paumer (Sarah Stango)

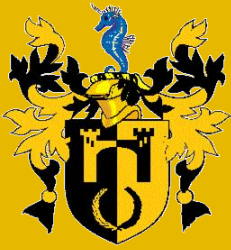

Disguising a Phone at an Event: An Experiment

So, when I was planning for my first event last July 2021 (yes, I am a baby SCAdian), I thought of hiding my phone as all the pages I saw recommended. This is no easy feat, as being a millennial, am almost constantly on my phone, at least according to all those silly millennial-hating articles from like 10 years ago.

So how to hide it, so those who don't want to see it won't see it? Why, simply hide it in a book! This ended up being both super easy and super hard. I essentially glued the pages together at the edges, then cut out an indent for my phone using an x-acto knife. Then once the hole was big enough, adding more glue to the page sides within the hole to stabilize the whole thing. I then just covered the outside with a plain brown paper and added felt to the spine and the inside cover. I was so proud of myself.

And after that first event, I haven't used it since.

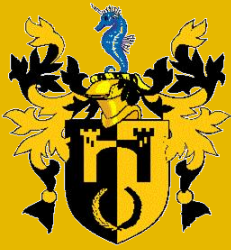


This was for two reasons. The first was that sometimes, you just got to look at your phone. Either to put in a new friend's contact info for later shenanigans, or maybe for taking a picture of someone's cool A&S display. The second was because unless you had a basket you were carrying, it's difficult to keep track of your phone and not have to carry the book. And if you need to have your hands free, this item can be overly cumbersome.

Maybe for retaining I'd bust this out again, so it looks like I'm either taking notes or reading out of a book while I use my phone for typing things in and keeping organized. But for practical use? This was not it.

So, for the second round of this, I thought about a pouch! Which does make sense, since pouches are all the rage these days. Everyone has a SOME sort of pouch.

I made this pouch specifically for my phone, since that's the whole point of this. I used the measurements of my phone. To be precise, I used the measurements of my phone plus



like 1-2 inches in every direction. This way my phone wouldn't be snug in the pouch and I could easily retrieve it. And if I needed to slip something in the pouch really quick, like my glasses or something, the pouch would have enough room. I'm on the right in the second picture, photo taken by Lord Rónán mac Ímair, and you can see the pouch hanging from my belt:



It's two layers of linen, for extra assurances that if my phone screen lights up it's more difficult to see it, and the two layers help soften the lines of the pop socket I have on my phone which prevents me from dropping it on my face when I'm sitting in bed alone at night scrolling on some app I'm using to distract me from reality. 😊

It also has two drawstrings, so the pouch can be pulled shut from both sides. The straps are long enough that I can easily loop it in a lark's head knot around whatever belt I'm wearing, and still long enough for me to open and close it.

I made this back in August 2021 to use while at Battle of the Bay. I've been using it for about six months now, and I have no complaints! I think the only thing I would change is the drawstrings. I used a random rope trim I picked up at Joann's. I want to replace them at some point with either some lucet cord or maybe a finger braid.

We really could use your help!

There are several positions in our Barony that could use a Deputy; actually, all of the positions that we have could benefit by having at least one deputy.

Why a Deputy? Well, it is easy for any one of us to intend to do something if we don't consider that the SCA is what we do with our time after we are finished doing what we do to pay the bills.

With deputies, the workload can be shared, allowing more work to be accomplished with less time and stress for any one individual.

Besides, it is a great way to work with others to do something different to help make yours, and others', SCA experience that much better!

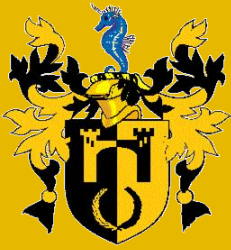

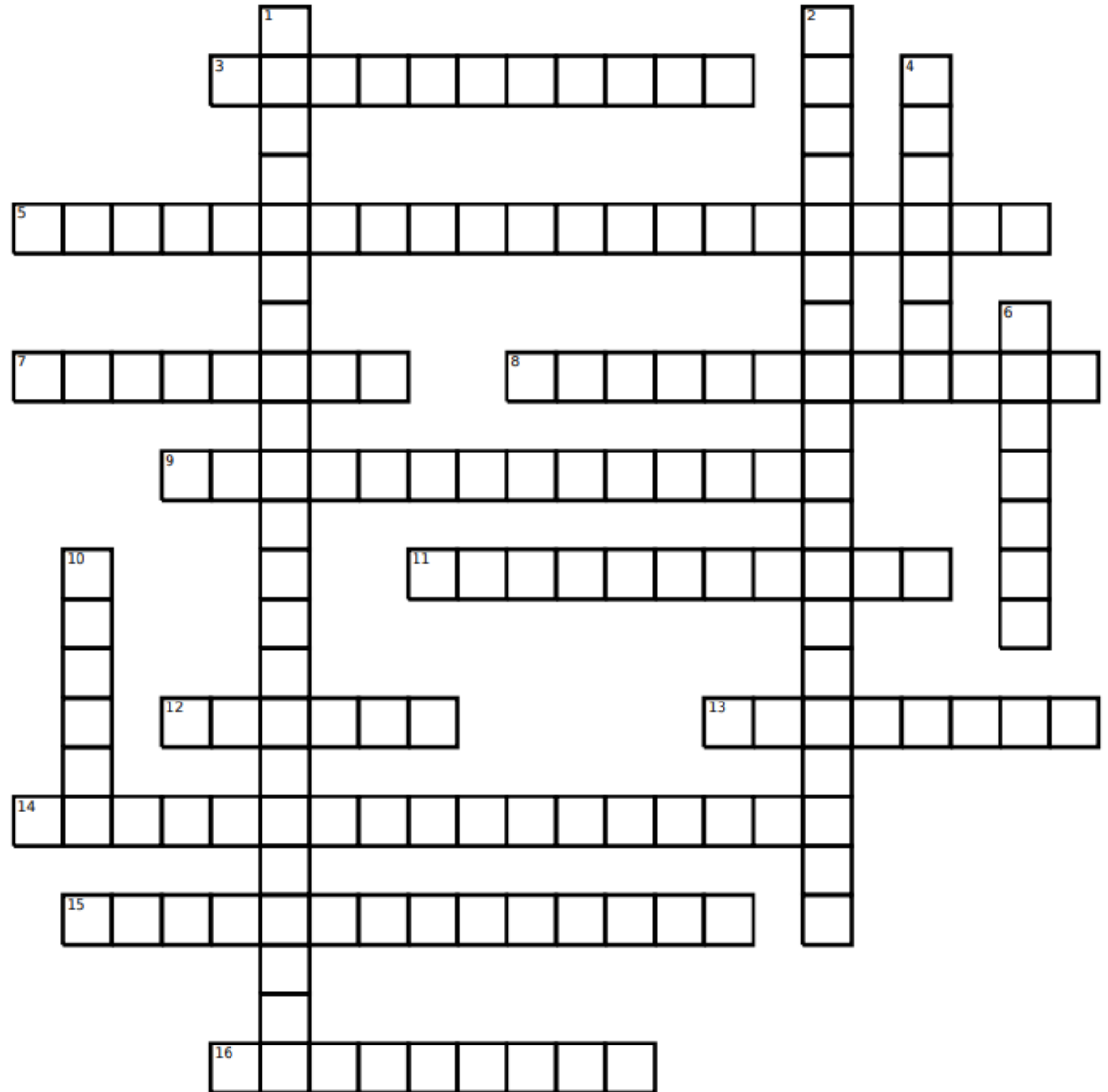

Non-Armigerous Kingdom Orders/Awards & Youth Awards Crossword

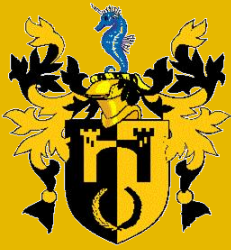

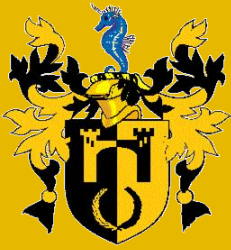
- Youth Award that honors and recognizes those young people (up to and including the age of 17), who have distinguished themselves by their service and contributions to the Kingdom of Atlantia.
- Non-Armigerous Kingdom Order: Conferred by the Queen/Consort of Atlantia upon such subjects as she deems worthy by reason of their consistently exemplary courtesy to subjects of all ranks in this Realm and in the Society at large. (4 Words)



7. Non-Armigerous Kingdom Award that recognizes and honors those who have performed acts of service for the Kingdom of Atlantia
8. Non-Armigerous Kingdom Award that recognizes those who have distinguished themselves by extraordinary contributions in ensuring the future of our Kingdom through our youth or new members; furthering their educational growth to become active and productive members of Atlantia (4 Words)
9. Non-Armigerous Kingdom Order: One becomes a member after successfully completing one reign as Consort. (4 Words)
11. Non-Armigerous Kingdom Award that recognizes and honors those who have performed acts of valor for the Kingdom of Atlantia (2 Words)
12. Youth Award that honors and recognizes those young people (up to and including the age of 17), who have distinguished themselves by their labors and achievements in the arts and sciences.
13. Youth Award that honors and recognizes those young people (up to and including the age of 17), who have distinguished themselves by acts of valor and chivalry in Youth martial activities. (2 Words)
14. Non-Armigerous Kingdom Award that honors and recognizes the ferocity and valor of a group of fighters as a whole, not as individuals. When they fight as a unit, the group will have the honor of carrying the banner with the heraldry of the award into battle. (2 Words)
15. Non-Armigerous Kingdom Award that honors and recognizes those who have distinguished themselves by an extraordinary achievement in the Arts and Sciences. (2 Words)
16. Youth Award that honors and recognizes those children (up to and including the age of 12), who have distinguished themselves by their contributions to the Kingdom of Atlantia in service, martial activities, and/or arts and sciences. (2 Words)

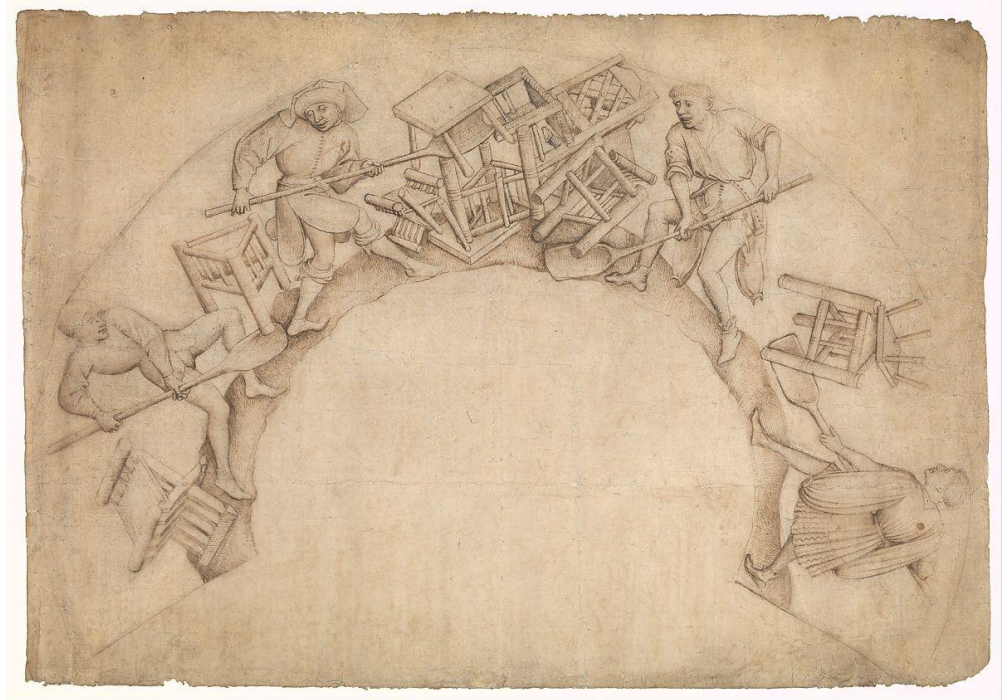
Down

1. Non-Armigerous Kingdom Award that honors and recognizes those who have distinguished themselves by their excellent contributions to the Kingdom of Atlantia. This award is a gift solely of the King/Sovereign to whomever is deemed deserving. (4 Words)
2. Non-Armigerous Kingdom Order: Admittance honors and recognizes those who have shown excellence, honor, courtesy or chivalry above and beyond any duty. The members exemplify what it means to be an Atlantian. This award may be given only once per reign and is conveyed solely at the discretion of the Crown (4 Words)
4. Youth Award that honors and recognizes those young people (up to and including the age of 17), who have distinguished themselves by their acts of courtesy.
6. Non-Armigerous Kingdom Award that honors and recognizes those who have distinguished themselves by extraordinary achievement as autocrats.

Art Spotlight: *Men Shoveling Chairs (Scupstoel)*

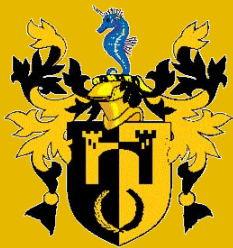
Circle of Rogier van der Weyden, possibly Vranke van der Stockt, Netherlandish, circa 1444-50



From the Met's website:

This remarkable drawing – among the few extant fifteenth-century designs for representational sculpture – is a study for one of three narrative capitals carved for the Brussels town hall between 1444 and 1450. The subject is a pun on the word *scupstoel* (literally “shovel chair”), a contraption used for public humiliation in which felons were raised above water and then dropped in. *Scupstoel* was also the name of a house that previously stood on the site of the new wing of the town hall. An inscription on the drawing's reverse indicates that the drawing served as a *patroen*, a model that may illustrate an intermediary stage between the preliminary sketch and the detailed pattern used by the sculptors of the capital. Its curved design suggests the three-dimensional form of the capital. Traditionally associated with the circle of Rogier van der Weyden, the renowned Netherlandish master who oversaw a large workshop as town painter of Brussels, the drawing recently has been attributed to Rogier's successor in this role: the painter Vrancke van der Stockt. A 19th-century reconstruction of the “*Scupstoel*” capital (after the original, Musée Communal, Brussels) is now on the ground floor arcade, L'Hôtel de Ville, Grande Place, Brussels.
